Day 1: (D) HOME TO CLARE TUESDAY, 14 OCTOBER 2025

Welcome to our 7 Day Flinders Ranges and Arkaroola tour! We head to Melbourne airport today to join our short direct flight to Adelaide. Upon arrival to Adelaide, we are met by our coach captain where we then make tracks for the beautiful Clare Valley for our overnight accommodation.

Day 2: (BLD) CLARE TO FLINDERS RANGES WEDNESDAY 15

We are in for a special visit this morning as we head to Bungaree Station. Established in 1841, Bungaree Station became the headquarters of an extensive sheep station with a hundred thousand merino sheep by the 1880s. Today it is an efficient mixed farm run by the descendants of the original founder, G.C. Hawker. A member of the family will give us a wonderful insight into nineteenth century station life with guided tour, morning tea, and delicious lunch. After our station experience, we continue north to our next two night's accommodation at **Rawnsley Park Station**, set below the magnificent Rawnsley Bluff in the Flinders Ranges. We will have some time to settle in before our dinner tonight at the Woolshed Restaurant, where the ever-changing menu makes the best of local produce.

Day 3: (BLD) DISCOVERING FLINDERS RANGES THURSDAY, 16

Today will be about discovering the beauty of Ikara-Flinders Ranges. We meet our local guide who will take us on an insiders tour of the stunning national park. We adventure into gorges to explore the landscape whilst hearing stories and seeing more than 800 million years of geological history. Wrap warmly as late afternoon we'll drive to Stokes Hill for Sundowners - nibbles and drinks as we watch the sun set with a spectacular backdrop.

Day 4: (BD) FLINDERS RANGES TO ARKARoola FRIDAY 17

We take our touring further into the Flinders today as we make our way to Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary in the Gammon Ranges National Park, one of Australia's true tourist gems. Not surprisingly, the sanctuary is colloquially known as "The Ark" which is quite fitting as the steep mountains and deep gorges provide shelter and a diversity of habitats which support amazing

species. On arrival lunch awaits us with time to take in the spectacular scenery. Later today we watch the rare Yellow Footed Rock Wallaby come in to feed in its natural environment close to where we sit to observe. Following dinner, we are in for another treat this time under the stars. There is nothing like an evening under a stunning tapestry of stars, taking in the amazing sight of the night sky in the dark Flinders Ranges. View the moon, stars, Milky Way and other celestial bodies up close through astronomy binoculars. The arid environment and elevation at Arkaroola, with the backdrop of the Flinders, provides the perfect environment for stargazing. There's little to no cloud cover, and the nearest town is over 100km away - that means virtually no light pollution. A truly memorable experience.

Day 5: (BLD) EXPLORING ARKAROOA SATURDAY, 18

This morning, we take the unforgettable 4WD Ridgetop Tour, showcasing timeless terrain and natural beauty of the Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary. An experienced tour guide will share their knowledge of Arkaroola's 1600 million year geological history as they navigate the famous Ridgetop Track. We'll explore ancient granite mountains, hillsides covered in native bush and several lookouts with breathtaking vistas. See the jaw dropping 1,000m deep Yundnamutana Gorge, the plains and Lake Frome salt lake. We return to Arkaroola for lunch before an afternoon at leisure. Take a self-guided walk, a scenic flight of the Gammon Ranges (own arrangements) or perhaps relax in the beautiful surroundings. The choice is yours!

Day 6: (BLD) ARKAROOA TO PORT AUGUSTA SUNDAY, 19

After an early breakfast, we travel back into the Flinders Ranges National Park and onto Hawker where we stop for lunch at the Flinders Food Co. We then have time to visit Jeff Morgan's Gallery where we not only see, but experience "Wilpena Panorama". This is a 360° view as seen from St Mary's Peak, the highest point of Wilpena Pound. The endless painting will have us mesmerised. Later this afternoon we arrive in Port Augusta, located on the Spencer Gulf. Port Augusta was once a major port and railway hub supporting the outback areas and the pastoral industry. Now the city is embracing new industries including renewable energy technologies. We have time to settle into our accommodation before our final dinner together on tour.
